Precautionary Boil Advisory

#MLGW is asking customers to conserve water. Doing so will help replenish the water reservoirs and restore water pressure levels.

You can help by:

- · Taking short showers instead of baths.
- · Postpone laundry day.
- · Put off running the dishwasher.
- Use paper plates, cups, and utensils instead which will also help reduce any risk of bacteria.







freezing pipes, let water drip from faucets served by exposed pipes and open cabinets to allow heated air to flow around pipes when the temperature dips below 32 degrees.



Precautionary Boil Advisory

Before you drink, cook with, or use your tap water to make ice, please boil it as a precaution:

- Bring it to a vigorous, rolling boil.
- Boil for three minutes.
- · Let it cool before using.



What to do now that the Boil Water Advisory is lifted:

- · Flush the plumbing in your home by running all cold water faucets for two minutes.
- Flush all appliances connected to the water line, like refrigerators.
- Disposable filters should be removed and replaced.
- Ice from ice makers should be dumped.



BOIL WATER



- A precautionary Boiled Water Advisory is in effect until further notice.
- Bring water for consumption to a roiling boil for 3 minutes.
 Boiled water is not needed to wash hands or to shower.
 Call the 24-hour Emergency
- Call the 24-hour Emergency number, 528-4465. If you see water coming out of the ground, out of homes, or out of businesses.

CONSERVE WATER

 There is reduced pressure across the water distribution system and reduced reservoir levels at several pumping stations.



 Customers are asked to voluntarily reduce water usage until further notice. This includes operating major appliances such as washing machines and dishwashers.

NO DISCONNECTS



- We are suspending all disconnects for nonpayments until further notice.
- Customers will be able to sign up for an extended payment program through the end of March.
